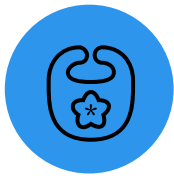
# HIGH BLOOD LEAD LEVEL?

Lead can cause problems with learning, hearing, speech and behavior.



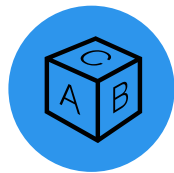
If your child's blood lead level is 5 ug/dL or above, the programs below can conduct a developmental screening and help to answer the questions you may be facing.

## Family support programs

## Has your child not been tested for lead?

Lead is found in many places where babies and children spend most of their time. A child with lead poisoning may not look or act sick. The only way to know for sure is to get your child tested. Contact your health care provider to discuss whether blood lead testing is appropriate for your child.
